Allowat Sakima: Very well, have all the preparations been made?

NUTIKET: I, Nutiket, Guard of this fire, have secured our meeting place and will remain watchful, as our brothers have done since the Order was founded on the banks of the Delaware river.

Allowat Sakima: It is well, For among those who are with us tonight, there are already some who are a part of The Order of the Arrow. They are those who have been recognized by their fellow scouts, and wear the sash over their right shoulder.

Meteu will now tell you a tale, of which all of you, members and non-members alike can learn much from

Meteu: Many years ago, when this part of the world was still new, there lived a mighty tribe. The warriors were strong and fierce, and the Chief was very wise.

Because of its strength, the tribe enjoyed peace for many years. However, one day an evil spirit in the form of a giant fire-breathing wolf came upon the tribe. Kitchkinet: (Nods Head) Brothers mark your candidates well

(Kitchkinet and torchbearers go into the stands and collect all nominated. KITCHKINET BRINGS THE FIRST PERSON DOWN) (music plays low, not on high)

Kitchkinet goes back up waits

Allowat: Nutiket, are there any others worthy of this honor?

Nutiket: Yes *points* (or) No Allowat Sakima, there are no others.

ALLOWAT: Very well. There are those who are already members of the lodge, who have continued to show dedication to both their unit and the lodge, and have chosen to attain Brotherhood Membership, when your name is called, please line up in front of Kitchkinet

(Names are called and moved to respective torchbearer to be taken for Nimat walk once complete)

ALLOWAT: Before we leave this assembly our lodge, it is only proper for Meteu to prepare us for the rest of our journeys

METEU: Oh Great Spirit, keep these scouts ready as they face their Ordeal. Allow them to be made one with you and your Earth. May your stars be their guides through darkness, and may all those assembled here be safe, until they return to you. This our purpose and intent. Mark with silence reverent.
